A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Law – Humane Society and Animal Control Officers – Education and**
3 **Training Requirements**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring an officer of a humane society and an animal control officer
5 to receive certain training within a certain period of time of employment; requiring
6 an officer of a humane society and an animal control officer to complete certain
7 continuing education at a certain time; and generally relating to education and
8 training requirements for humane society and animal control officers.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Criminal Law**

17 10–609.

18 (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this section, if an officer of a
19 humane society sees a person committing a misdemeanor that involves cruelty to an
20 animal, the officer shall arrest and bring before the District Court the person committing
21 the misdemeanor.

22 (b) In Calvert County, if an officer of a humane society or an animal control officer
23 appointed by the County Commissioners or the County Commissioners' designee sees a
24 person committing a misdemeanor that involves cruelty to an animal, the officer shall
25 arrest and bring before the District Court the person committing the misdemeanor.

1 (c) In Baltimore County, the Baltimore County Department of Health, Division
2 of Animal Control shall enforce this section.

3 (D) (1) **WITHIN THE FIRST 12 MONTHS OF EMPLOYMENT, AN OFFICER OF**
4 **A HUMANE SOCIETY OR AN ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER SHALL SATISFACTORILY**
5 **COMPLETE AT LEAST 80 HOURS OF TRAINING FOR ANIMAL CARE AND CONTROL**
6 **PROFESSIONALS THAT IS APPROVED BY THE APPROPRIATE UNIT OF A COUNTY OR**
7 **MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.**

8 (2) **AN OFFICER OF A HUMANE SOCIETY OR AN ANIMAL CONTROL**
9 **OFFICER SHALL SATISFACTORILY COMPLETE AT LEAST 6 HOURS OF CONTINUING**
10 **EDUCATION APPROVED BY THE APPROPRIATE UNIT OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL**
11 **CORPORATION EVERY YEAR.**

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2020.
