 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Fort Monroe National

5 Monument Land Acquisition Act".

6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

7 In this Act:

8 (1) MAP.—The term "map" means the map9 prepared by the National Park Service entitled

1 "Fort Monroe National Monument Proposed Land 2 Conveyance", numbered 250/154572A, and dated July 2019. 3 4 (2)MONUMENT.—The term "Monument" 5 means the Fort Monroe National Monument in the 6 State. 7 (3) NON-FEDERAL LAND.—The term "non-Fed-8 eral land" means the approximately 44 acres of land 9 in the State depicted on the map as "Commonwealth 10 of Virginia Land (Fee) Proposed for Conveyance to 11 the NPS" and "Commonwealth of Virginia Interest 12 (Easement) Proposed for Conveyance to the NPS". 13 (4) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means 14 the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Di-15 rector of the National Park Service. (5) STATE.—The term "State" means the State 16 17 of Virginia. 18 SEC. 3. CONVEYANCE OF NON-FEDERAL LAND FOR THE 19 FORT MONROE NATIONAL MONUMENT. 20 (a) IN GENERAL.—If the State offers to convey to the United States the non-Federal land— 21 22 (1) the Secretary shall accept the offer; and 23 (2) on conveyance to the United States of the 24 non-Federal land, the non-Federal land shall be

1 added to, and administered by the Secretary as part 2 of, the Monument. 3 (b) CORRECTIONS.—The Secretary and the State 4 may, by mutual agreement— 5 (1) make minor boundary adjustments to the non-Federal land to be conveyed under subsection 6 7 (a); and 8 (2) correct any minor errors in the map. 9 (c) RESERVATION OF RIGHTS.—As part of the con-10 veyance of the non-Federal land to the United States 11 under subsection (a), the State may reserve and retain the rights of the State under any leases in existence on the 12 13 non-Federal land on the day before the date of the convey-14 ance.
