#### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### 2 Criminal Law – Assault in the First Degree – Suffocation or Strangulation

## FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from committing an assault by intentionally suffocating or strangling another; providing a penalty for a violation of this Act; and generally relating to criminal assault.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 13 Article Criminal Law
- 14 3–202.

15 (a) (1) A person may not intentionally cause or attempt to cause serious 16 physical injury to another.

(2) A person may not commit an assault with a firearm, including:

18 (i) a handgun, antique firearm, rifle, shotgun, short–barreled 19 shotgun, or short–barreled rifle, as those terms are defined in § 4–201 of this article;

(ii) an assault pistol, as defined in § 4-301 of this article;

#### 4 (3) A PERSON MAY NOT COMMIT AN ASSAULT BY INTENTIONALLY 5 SUFFOCATING OR STRANGLING ANOTHER.

6 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of the felony of assault in the first 7 degree and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 25 years.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2020.
