VEHICLES BY ALLOWING MANUFACTURERS TO SELL THEIR OWN

### **Bill Summary**

Current law states that, with certain exceptions, a motor vehicle manufacturer may not own, operate, or control any motor vehicle dealer or used motor vehicle dealer in Colorado. The bill creates a new exception that allows the ownership, operation, or control of a motor vehicle dealer that sells electric motor vehicles of a manufacturer's SENATE

line-make. An "electric motor vehicle" is a motor vehicle that can operate entirely on electrical power.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-20-126, amend
3	(2)(c) and (2)(d); and repeal (2)(e) and (2)(f) as follows:
4	44-20-126. Independent control of dealer - definitions.
5	(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the following
6	activities are not prohibited:
7	(c) Participation in the ownership of the dealer solely for the
8	purpose of providing financing or a capital loan that will enable the dealer
9	to become the majority owner of the dealer in less than seven years; OR
10	(d) OWNERSHIP, operation, OR CONTROL of a ONE OR MORE motor
11	vehicle dealer DEALERS if the manufacturer MANUFACTURES ONLY
12	ELECTRIC VEHICLES AND has no other FRANCHISED dealers of the same
13	<u>line-make in this state.</u>
14	(e) Ownership, operation, or control of a used motor vehicle
15	dealer if the manufacturer owned, operated, or controlled the used motor
16	vehicle dealer on January 1, 2009, and has continuously operated or
17	controlled the used motor vehicle facilities after January 1, 2009; and
18	(f) Operation of a motor vehicle dealer if the manufacturer was
19	operating the dealer on January 1, 2009, so long as the dealer is in
20	continuous operation after January 1, 2009.
21	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -
22	applicability. (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
23	the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
24	general assembly (August 5, 2020, if adjournment sine die is on May 6,
25	2020); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1

1	(3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
2	or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part
3	will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election
4	to be held in November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the
5	date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
6	(2) This act applies to ownership, operation, or control of a motor
7	vehicle dealer on or after the applicable effective date of this act.
