A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-5-46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 trafficking of persons for labor or sexual servitude, so as to expand the offense of trafficking
- 3 an individual for sexual servitude; to change the punishment for a certain type of trafficking
- 4 an individual for sexual servitude; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 5 and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 16-5-46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to trafficking of
- 9 persons for labor or sexual servitude, is amended by revising paragraph (3) of subsection (c)
- and paragraph (5) of subsection (f) as follows:
- 11 "(3) Solicits or patronizes by any means an individual to perform sexually explicit
- 12 conduct on behalf of such person when such individual is the subject of sexual servitude."
- 13 "(5) Any person who violates paragraph (3) of subsection (c) of this Code section shall
- be guilty of a felony. When such offense is committed against an individual who is 16
- or 17 years of age or older, upon conviction, such person shall be punished by
- imprisonment for not less than five nor more than 20 years. When such offense is
- 17 committed against an individual who is younger than 16 years of age or an individual
- 18 known to have a developmental disability, upon conviction, such person shall be
- punished by imprisonment for not less than ten nor more than 20 years."

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
