The Senate Committee on Education and Youth offered the following substitute to HB 759:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 20-2-2114 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
qualifications for the Georgia Special Needs Scholarship Program, so as to revise the prior
school year requirement; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

Code Section 20-2-2114 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to qualifications for the Georgia Special Needs Scholarship Program, is amended by revising paragraph (3) of subsection (a) as follows:

"(3) The student:

- (A) Has spent the prior school year in attendance at a Georgia public school; provided, however, that this requirement shall not apply if:
 - (i) The the student's parent is an active duty military service member stationed in Georgia within the previous year; or
 - (ii) The student previously qualified for a scholarship pursuant to this paragraph; provided, however, that a student may only requalify pursuant to this subdivision one time and such requalification shall be within 18 months of the original qualification; and
- (B) Has an Individualized Education Program written in accordance with federal and state laws and regulations; provided, however, that the State Board of Education shall be authorized to require a local board of education to expedite the development of an Individualized Education Program and to waive the prior school year requirement contained in subparagraph (A) of this paragraph, in its sole discretion, on a case-by-case basis for specific medical needs of the student upon the request of a parent or guardian in accordance with state board procedures. If an expedited Individualized Education Program is required by the state board pursuant to this subparagraph, the state board

28	of the school year. The State Board of Education shall provide an annual report by
29	December 31 of each year through December 31, 2015, regarding the number of
