## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to ensure that children of homeless veterans are included in the calculation of the amounts of certain per diem grants.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Homeless Veteran  
5 Families Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF CALCULATION OF AMOUNTS OF**  
7 **PER DIEM GRANTS.**

8 Section 2012(a)(2)(B) of title 38, United States  
9 Code, is amended—

1           (1) in clause (i), by inserting “or (iii)” after  
2 “clause (ii)”; and

3           (2) by adding at the end the following new  
4 clause:

5           “(iii) With respect to a homeless veteran who  
6 has care of a minor dependent while receiving serv-  
7 ices from the grant recipient or eligible entity, the  
8 daily cost of care shall be the sum of the daily cost  
9 of care determined under subparagraph (A) plus, for  
10 each such minor dependent, an amount that equals  
11 50 percent of such daily cost of care.”.
