## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to require a full military honors ceremony for certain deceased veterans, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Full Military Honors
- 5 Act of 2019".
- 6 SEC. 2. FULL MILITARY HONORS CEREMONY FOR CERTAIN
- 7 VETERANS.
- 8 Section 1491(b) of title 10, United States Code, is
- 9 amended by adding at the end the following:

1	"(3) The Secretary concerned shall provide full mili-
2	tary honors (as determined by the Secretary concerned)
3	for the funeral of a veteran who—
4	"(A) is first interred or first inurned in Arling-
5	ton National Cemetery on or after the date of the
6	enactment of the Full Military Honors Act of 2019;
7	"(B) was awarded the medal of honor or the
8	prisoner-of-war medal; and
9	"(C) is not entitled to full military honors by
10	the grade of that veteran.".
