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#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Pollinator Habitat Plans – Plan Contents – Requirement <u>Requirements</u> and Prohibition

FOR the purpose of requiring a certain pollinator habitat plan to include certain best 4 management practices for the designation of certain habitat areas; requiring that a  $\mathbf{5}$ certain pollinator habitat plan established by the Department of Natural Resources, 6 7 the Maryland Environmental Service, and the State Highway Administration be as 8 protective of pollinators as the Department of Agriculture's managed pollinator 9 protection plan; prohibiting the use of certain pesticides, seeds, or plants, seeds, or plants in the pollinator habitat plan a certain pollinator habitat area, subject to 10 certain exceptions; defining a <del>a certain term</del> certain term; making conforming 11 12changes; and generally relating to pollinator habitat plans.
