- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Environment
- 16 **9–321.3**.
- 17 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- 18 (1) MONITOR EFFLUENT DISCHARGED FROM SEWAGE TREATMENT
- 19 PLANTS; AND
- 20 (2) EVALUATE WHETHER THE EFFLUENT AND ANY NUTRIENTS IN THE
- 21 EFFLUENT IMPACTS MIDGE POPULATIONS IN THE SURROUNDING LAND AND WATER
- 22 AREAS, INCLUDING WHETHER THE EFFLUENT CONTRIBUTES TO THE GROWTH OF
- 23 PHYTOPLANKTON.



- ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2021, AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE 1 (B) 2
- DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH
- 3 § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED
- IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION. 4
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 2020.
