A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to permitting a dog or domestic animal to enter or remain on private**
2 **property without authorization."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 03.55 is amended by adding new sections to read:

5 **Article 3. Control of Animals.**

6 **Sec. 03.55.200. Failure to control animal.** (a) The owner and the person
7 having custody and control of a dog or domestic animal may not permit the dog or
8 domestic animal to enter or remain on private property outside a controlled livestock
9 district under AS 03.35.010 - 03.35.070 without authorization.

10 (b) Permitting a dog or domestic animal to enter or remain on private property
11 without authorization is a violation.

12 **Sec. 03.55.290. Definitions.** In AS 03.55.200 - 03.55.290, "domestic animal"
13 has the meaning given in AS 03.35.070.
