	(b) determine the duties and role of an ombudsman program in protecting the rights
and	d privileges of an individual with a disability and addressing the barriers identified in

	(c) based on the information described in Subsections (2)(a) and (b), develop a
pro	oposal for an ombudsman program to promote and advocate for the rights and privileges of
<u>an</u>	individual with a disability; and
	(d) before November 30, 2021, report to the Health and Human Services Interim
<u>Co</u>	emmittee regarding the proposal described in Subsection (2)(c) and any recommendations for
<u>im</u>	plementation of the proposal.
	(3) In developing the proposal described in Subsection (2)(c), the department shall:
	(a) review statutes, policies, and programs in other states relating to an ombudsman
wh	no provides services to an individual with a disability; and
	(b) consult with:
	(i) the Department of Health; and
	(ii) other stakeholders, as determined by the department.
