## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 13 of Title 19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to granting of relief by superior courts, so as to revise the definition of family
- 3 violence to include certain acts between persons through whom a past or present pregnancy
- 4 has developed or persons in a past or present dating relationship for the granting of protective
- 5 orders and other relief; to provide for definitions; to require the court to make certain
- 6 findings prior to granting protective orders alleging dating relationships; to provide for
- 7 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

- 10 Article 1 of Chapter 13 of Title 19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- granting of relief by superior courts, is amended by revising Code Section 19-13-1, relating
- 12 to "family violence" defined, as follows:
- 13 "19-13-1.
- 14 As used in this article, the term:
- 15 (1) 'Dating relationship' means a romantic or intimate social relationship that is
- characterized by a level of intimacy, knowledge, or affection that is not associated with
- 17 <u>a casual acquaintanceship or between persons in an ordinary business, social, or</u>
- education context; provided, however, that 'dating relationship' shall not require sexual
- involvement.
- 20 (2) 'Family 'family violence' means the occurrence of one or more of the following acts
- between past or present spouses, persons who are parents of the same child, parents and
- 22 children, stepparents and stepchildren, foster parents and foster children, <del>or other</del> persons
- 23 living or formerly living in the same household, persons through whom a past or present
- 24 pregnancy has developed, or persons in a past or present dating relationship:

- 26 (2)(B) Commission of offenses of battery, simple battery, simple assault, assault,
- stalking, criminal damage to property, unlawful restraint, or criminal trespass.
- 28 The term 'family violence' shall not be deemed to include reasonable discipline
- administered by a parent to a child in the form of corporal punishment, restraint, or
- 30 detention."
- 31 SECTION 2.
- 32 Said article is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 33 "19-13-3.1.
- 34 <u>In order to determine if a protective order alleging a dating relationship shall be granted</u>
- pursuant to Code Section 19-13-4, the court shall find that:
- 36 (1) There is a minimal social interpersonal bonding of the parties over and above that of
- 37 mere casual acquaintance or ordinary fraternization; and
- 38 (2) Factors exist which indicate that the nature and frequency of the parties' interactions
- 39 <u>are reflective of a dating relationship, including, but not limited to, the length and pattern</u>
- 40 <u>of the relationship between the parties or the parties having demonstrated an affirmation</u>
- of a dating relationship before others by statement or conduct."

43 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
