## A BILL

To authorize the posthumous honorary promotion to general of Lieutenant General Frank Maxwell Andrews, United States Army.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. POSTHUMOUS HONORARY PROMOTION TO 4 **GENERAL OF LIEUTENANT GENERAL FRANK** 5 MAXWELL ANDREWS, UNITED STATES ARMY. 6 (a) POSTHUMOUS HONORARY PROMOTION.—Not-7 withstanding any time limitation with respect to post-8 humous promotions for persons who served in the Armed 9 Forces, the President is authorized to issue a posthumous 10 honorary commission promoting Lieutenant General

Frank Maxwell Andrews, United States Army, to the
grade of general.

3 (b) ADDITIONAL BENEFITS NOT TO ACCRUE.—The 4 honorary promotion of Frank Maxwell Andrews under 5 subsection (a) shall not affect the retired pay or other ben-6 efits from the United States to which Frank Maxwell An-7 drews would have been entitled based upon his military 8 service or affect any benefits to which any other person 9 may become entitled based on his military service.
