## 2 Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Barbershop and Beauty Salon 3 License

FOR the purpose of establishing a barbershop and beauty salon beer and wine license in 4 5 Anne Arundel County; specifying the individuals who are qualified to hold the 6 license; authorizing a license holder to serve a certain amount of beer or wine by the 7 glass to a customer for on-premises consumption under certain circumstances; specifying the hours during which a license holder is authorized to serve beer and 8 9 wine; stating that a license holder need not obtain a certain Sunday license; 10 establishing an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in 11 Anne Arundel County.
