- Article Tax General 1511 - 211.1617(b) The sales and use tax does not apply to a sale of: 18 (10)**(I)** a replacement cord for an artificial hearing device; A CUSTOM-MADE EARMOLD FOR AN ARTIFICIAL HEARING 19**(II)** 20**DEVICE; OR** 21(III) ANY OTHER ARTIFICIAL HEARING **DEVICE-RELATED** 22**EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES;**



1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 2 1, 2020.
