A BILL

To delay the reimposition of the annual fee on health insurance providers until after 2021.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Health Insurance Tax
- 5 Relief Act of 2019".

- 1 SEC. 2. DELAY OF REIMPOSITION OF ANNUAL FEE ON
- 2 HEALTH INSURANCE PROVIDERS UNTIL
- 3 **AFTER 2021.**
- 4 (a) In General.—Section 9010(j)(3) of the Patient
- 5 Protection and Affordable Care Act is amended by strik-
- 6 ing "December 31, 2019" and inserting "December 31,
- 7 2021".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 9 this section shall apply to calendar years beginning after
- 10 December 31, 2019.
