A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions regarding ad valorem taxation of property, so as to provide that
- 3 property tax bills shall not include any nontax related fees or assessments; to provide for
- 4 applicability; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 general provisions regarding ad valorem taxation of property, is amended by revising Code
- 10 Section 48-5-33, which is reserved, as follows:
- 11 "48-5-33.
- 12 (a) No property tax bill issued by the tax commissioner or other local fiscal authority for
- the collection and payment of ad valorem taxes on real property shall include any nontax
- related fees or assessments, including, but not limited to, storm-water service fees or solid
- waste service fees. Any collection and payment of such nontax related fees or assessments
- shall be addressed in separate billings from property tax bills; provided, however, that this
- 17 <u>shall not preclude a tax commissioner or other local fiscal authority from including</u>
- 18 <u>multiple billings in the same mailing.</u>
- 19 (b) If the taxpayer remits only a partial payment to the tax commissioner or other local
- 20 <u>fiscal authority</u>, such partial payment shall first be applied to the outstanding balance of ad
- 21 <u>valorem taxes on real property which are due and payable.</u>
- 22 (c) This Code section shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning on or after January
- 23 <u>1, 2017.</u> Reserved."
- SECTION 2.
- 25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
