A BILL

To require reimbursement for costs associated with Presidential travel, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Stop Padding Presi-
- 5 dential Pockets Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REIMBURSEMENT REQUIRED.
- 7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in the
- 8 case of a person whom the United States Secret Service

1	is authorized to protect under paragraph (1) or (2) of sec-
2	tion 3056(a) of title 18, United States Code, if that person
3	travels domestically or internationally in furtherance of
4	the business interests of an entity owned by or controlled
5	by the President of the United States, or from which the
6	President of the United States receives any financial ben-
7	efit, that person shall reimburse to the Treasury—
8	(1) amount expended by the United States Se-
9	cret Service for the provision of such protection; and
10	(2) any amount expended for other costs in-
11	curred by the Government pertaining to that travel.
