FOR the purpose of requiring the Public Service Commission to issue an order that sets certain rates for electricity and gas for certain residential customers in Baltimore City that meet certain criteria at a certain percentage lower than the rates for other residential customers in Baltimore City; defining a certain term; and generally

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (A) IN THIS SECTION "QUALIFIED RESIDENTICE

18(A) IN THIS SECTION, "QUALIFIED RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER" MEANS A19RESIDENTIAL GAS OR ELECTRIC CUSTOMER IN BALTIMORE CITY WHO:

- 20 (1) IS 55 YEARS OLD OR OLDER; AND
- 21(2) HAS BEEN A CUSTOMER OF THE ELECTRIC COMPANY, GAS22COMPANY, OR ELECTRIC AND GAS COMPANY FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR.

1 (B) FOR SERVICES REGULATED BY THE COMMISSION, THE COMMISSION 2 SHALL ISSUE AN ORDER THAT SETS THE RATES FOR ELECTRICITY AND GAS FOR 3 QUALIFIED RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS AT 10% LOWER THAN THE RATES FOR OTHER 4 RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS IN BALTIMORE CITY.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2017.
