9 An Act relating to criminal procedure; providing time
10 limitation for executing and returning misdemeanor
11 traffic warrants; providing exceptions; declaring
12 warrants void unless executed; directing district
13 court clerks to forward certain information to the
14 Department of Public Safety; directing all fines,
15 fees and costs to be waived; providing for
16 codification; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1114.4 of Title 22, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 Except for alcohol- or drug-related traffic offenses, eluding,
22 and negligent homicide, as provided in Section 11-903 of Title 47 of
23 the Oklahoma Statutes, every misdemeanor traffic warrant issued on
24 or after the effective date of this act shall be executed and
 returned to the district court by whom it was issued within seven
 (7) years after the date of the citation. After the expiration of

1 such time, the warrant, unless executed, is void and the citation
2 shall be dismissed. The district court clerk shall update the
3 abstract of court record portion of the citation with the
4 disposition information of the case and forward the abstract of
5 court record to the Department of Public Safety, as provided for in
6 Section 18-101 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Any fines,
7 fees or costs associated with the citation shall be waived in their
8 entirety.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
