The department shall, prior to approving 13 a licensed driver training school to conduct tests as provided in this subsection, make a 14 determination that the school has been licensed for a minimum of two years and has conducted driver education courses on a full-time basis for such two-year period and that 15 16 such school meets all other standards which the department may establish as a condition 17 for approval to conduct such tests. The department shall authorize a driver training school licensed pursuant to Chapter 13 of Title 43 and approved by the department to 18 19 administer the on-the-road driving skills testing provided for in this Code section, 20 provided that the applicant has successfully completed: 21 (A) A a driver training course which includes a minimum of 30 class hours of 22 instruction and six hours of private in-car training; 23 (B) An online driver education course licensed by the department and consisting of a 24 minimum of 30 hours of instruction in addition to six hours of private in-car instruction 25 provided by a driver training school licensed to provide such in-car training;
