A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Health – Contraceptive Devices – Minors**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a health care provider from inserting or implanting a
4 contraceptive device into the body of a minor unless the minor's parent or guardian
5 provides a certain written authorization; and generally relating to contraceptive
6 devices and minors.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Health – General**

15 **20–103.1.**

16 **A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER, AS DEFINED IN § 5–601 OF THIS ARTICLE, MAY**
17 **NOT INSERT OR IMPLANT A CONTRACEPTIVE DEVICE, INCLUDING AN INTRAUTERINE**
18 **DEVICE OR IMPLANTABLE ROD, INTO THE BODY OF A MINOR UNLESS THE MINOR'S**
19 **PARENT OR GUARDIAN PROVIDES WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FOR THE MINOR TO**
20 **HAVE THE DEVICE INSERTED OR IMPLANTED.**

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2020.
