- A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER, AS DEFINED IN § 5–601 OF THIS ARTICLE, MAY
- 17 NOT INSERT OR IMPLANT A CONTRACEPTIVE DEVICE, INCLUDING AN INTRAUTERINE
- 18 DEVICE OR IMPLANTABLE ROD, INTO THE BODY OF A MINOR UNLESS THE MINOR'S
- 19 PARENT OR GUARDIAN PROVIDES WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FOR THE MINOR TO
- 20 HAVE THE DEVICE INSERTED OR IMPLANTED.
