1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Gulf Conservation and3 Recreation Funding Act".

4 SEC. 2. PAYMENTS TO GULF PRODUCING STATES AND
5 COASTAL POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS TO COM6 PENSATE FOR REDUCTIONS IN PAYMENTS
7 RESULTING FROM MORATORIUM ON NEW
8 OFFSHORE OIL AND NATURAL GAS LEASES.

9 Section 105(b) of the Gulf of Mexico Energy Security
10 Act of 2006 (43 U.S.C. 1331 note) is amended by adding
11 at the end the following:

12 "(4) PAYMENTS TO GULF PRODUCING STATES 13 TO COMPENSATE FOR REDUCTIONS IN OTHER PAY-14 MENTS RESULTING FROM MORATORIUM ON NEW 15 LEASES.—In addition to the other payments re-16 quired by this subsection, during the effective period 17 of the moratorium on new oil and natural gas leases 18 in offshore waters under Executive Order 14008 of 19 January 27, 2021, the Secretary shall pay to each 20 Gulf producing State and each coastal political sub-21 division each fiscal year an amount equal to the dif-22 ference between the amount of such other payments 23 for the fiscal year to the State or subdivision, re-24 spectively, and the average annual amount of such 25 other payments to the State or subdivision, respec-

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- 1 tively, for fiscal years after fiscal year 2017 and up
- 2 to fiscal year 2020.".
