AN ACT

- To amend title 49, United State Code, to require small hub airports to construct areas for nursing mothers, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act may be cited as the "Friendly Airports for 2 Mothers Improvement Act". 4 SEC. 2. MOTHERS' ROOMS. 5 Section 47107(w) of title 49, United States Code, is amended— 6 7 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking "In fiscal year 8 2021" and all that follows through "the Secretary of Transportation" and inserting "The Secretary of 9 10 Transportation"; (2) in paragraph (1)(B) by striking "one men's 11 and one women's" and inserting "at least one men's 12 13 and at least one women's"; 14 (3) by striking paragraph (2)(A) and inserting 15 the following: "(A) AIRPORT SIZE.— 16 "(i) IN GENERAL.—The requirements 17 18 in paragraph (1) shall only apply to appli-19 cations submitted by the airport sponsor 20 of— "(I) a medium or large hub air-21 22 port in fiscal year 2021 and each fis-23 cal year thereafter; and 24 "(II) an applicable small hub air-25 port in fiscal year 2023 and each fis-

cal year thereafter.

2	PORT DEFINED.—In clause (i)(II), the
3	term 'applicable small hub airport' means
4	an airport designated as a small hub air-
5	port during—
6	"(I) the 3-year period consisting
7	of 2020, 2021, and 2022; or

9	riod beginning after 2020.";
10	(4) in paragraph (2)(B) by striking "the date
11	of enactment of this Act complies with the require-
12	ment in paragraph (1)" and inserting "October 5,
13	2018, complies with the requirement in paragraph
14	(1)(A)"; and
15	(5) in paragraph (2)(C) by striking "paragraph
16	(1)" and inserting "paragraph (1)(A)".
