1 SECTION 1. AUTHORITY OF DIRECTORS OF VETERANS IN 2 TEGRATED SERVICE NETWORKS TO INVES 3 TIGATE MEDICAL CENTERS OF THE DEPART 4 MENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Director of a Veterans Inte-6 grated Service Network of the Department of Veterans Af-7 fairs may contract with an appropriate entity specializing 8 in civilian accreditation or health care evaluation to inves-9 tigate any medical center within such Network to assess 10 and report deficiencies of the facilities at such medical 11 center.

12 (b) COORDINATION.—Before entering into any con-13 tract under subsection (a), the Director of a Veterans Integrated Service Network shall notify the Secretary of Vet-14 erans Affairs, the Inspector General of the Department 15 16 of Veterans Affairs, and the Comptroller General of the United States for purposes of coordinating any investiga-17 18 tion conducted pursuant to such contract with any other 19 investigations or accreditations that may be ongoing.

20 (c) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec-21 tion may be construed—

(1) to prevent the Office of the Inspector General of the Department of Veterans Affairs from
conducting any review, audit, evaluation, or inspection regarding a topic for which a review is conducted under subsection (a); or

(2) to modify the requirement that employees of
 the Department assist with any review, audit, eval uation, or inspection conducted by the Office of the
 Inspector General of the Department.
