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SECTION 1-2.

(a) In the event that, in the 2018 session, the General Assembly creates the City of Eagle's 75 76 Landing and such creation is ratified by the voters in 2018 and the City of Stockbridge has 77 annexed into the City of Stockbridge parcels of property which are contained in the corporate 78 limits of the newly incorporated City of Eagle's Landing, such annexed parcels shall no 79 longer be a part of the City of Stockbridge on January 1, 2019, and shall become part of the 80 City of Eagle's Landing. 81 (b) In the event that, in the 2018 session, the General Assembly creates the City of Eagle's 82 Landing and such creation is ratified by the voters in 2018, and the City of Stockbridge has annexed into the City of Stockbridge parcels of property which are not contained in the 83 84 corporate limits of the new incorporated City of Eagle's Landing and which are no longer contiguous to the corporate boundaries of the City of Stockbridge, such annexed parcels shall 85 no longer be a part of the City of Stockbridge on January 1, 2019, and shall become part of 86

87 unincorporated Henry County.

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PART II

SECTION 2-1.

- Said Act is further amended by revising Section 1.11 by designating the existing text assubsection (a) and inserting a new subsection to read as follows:

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SECTION 2-2.

The election superintendent of Henry County shall call and conduct an election as provided in this section for the purpose of submitting this Act to the electors of the territory sought to be annexed into the City of Stockbridge under this Act for approval or rejection. The election superintendent shall conduct such election on the date of and in conjunction with the 2018 General Primary and shall issue the call and conduct such election as provided by general law. The election superintendent shall cause the date and purpose of the election to be published once a week for two weeks immediately preceding the date thereof in the official organ of Henry County. The ballot shall have written or printed thereon the words:

134 "() YES Shall the Act be approved which annexes certain land into the City of

135 () NO Stockbridge?"

All persons desiring to vote for approval of the annexation shall vote "Yes" and all persons 136 desiring to vote for rejection of the annexation shall vote "No." If more than one-half of the 137 votes cast on such question are for approval of the annexation, then Section 2-1 of this Act 138 shall become effective on January 1, 2019. If more than one-half of the votes cast on such 139 question are for rejection of the annexation or if the election is not held as provided in this 140 section, then Part II of this Act shall automatically be repealed on January 1, 2019. The 141 expense of such election shall be borne by the City of Stockbridge. It shall be the election 142 143 superintendent's duty to certify the result thereof to the Secretary of State.

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PART III

SECTION 3-1.

(a) Part I of this Act shall become effective on January 1, 2019, provided that an Act to
create the City of Eagle's Landing is enacted in the 2018 session of the General Assembly
and is ratified by the voters in 2018. If no such Act is enacted or if it is not ratified by the
voters, then Part I of this Act shall not be effective and shall be repealed by operation of law
on January 1, 2019.

(b) Except as provided in Section 2-2 of this Act, Part II of this Act shall become effective 151 152 upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval, provided that an Act to create the City of Eagle's Landing is enacted in the 2018 session of the General 153 Assembly and signed by the Governor. If no such Act is enacted and signed by the 154 155 Governor, then Part II of this Act shall not be effective and shall be repealed by operation of law on January 1, 2019. 156 (c) Part III of this Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its 157 158 becoming law without such approval.

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SECTION 3-2.

- 160 Directory nature of dates.
- 161 It is the intention of the General Assembly that this Act be construed as directory rather than
- 162 mandatory with respect to any date prescribed in this Act. If it is necessary to delay any

action called for in this Act for providential cause or any other reason, it is the intention of
the General Assembly that the action be delayed rather than abandoned. Any delay in
performing any action under this Act, whether for cause or otherwise, shall not operate to
frustrate the overall intent of this Act. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, it is
specifically provided that:

- 168 (1) If it is not possible to hold the referendum election provided for in Section 2-2 of this
- Act on the date specified in that section, then such referendum shall be held as soonthereafter as is reasonably practicable; and
- 171 (2) If the bill creating the City of Eagle's Landing is enacted by the General Assembly
- in 2018 but the referendum on the incorporation of the City of Eagle's Landing is delayed
- for any reason, then the dates in this Act shall be adjusted accordingly to accommodatesuch delay.
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SECTION 3-3.

176 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
