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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 45 receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the 46 organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall 47 deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that 48 organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend 49 the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same 50 manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends 51 other money in that fund. 52

The registrar shall pay the contributions received pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs and autism awareness efforts throughout the state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services directly to their clients.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with pancreatic cancer and their families.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 70 receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the 71 Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the 72 contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social 73 support services for adults who have sickle cell disease. 74

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The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 75 receives pursuant to section 4503.497 of the Revised Code to the 76 St. Baldrick's foundation, which shall use the contributions for 77 its research and other programs. 78

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 83 receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the 84 children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the 85 contributions for its research and other programs. 86

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 87 receives pursuant to section 4503.4910 of the Revised Code to 88 the KylerStrong foundation, which shall use the contributions to 89 raise awareness of brain cancer caused by diffuse intrinsic 90 pontine glioma and to fund research for the cure of such cancer. 91

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 92 receives pursuant to section 4503.4911 of the Revised Code to 93 the research institution for childhood cancer at nationwide 94 children's hospital, which shall use the contributions to fund 95 research for the cure of childhood cancers. 96

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 97 receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 98 future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 99 contributions into its general account to be used for 100 educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 101 America foundation. 102

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 103

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receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 104 4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university 105 extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay 106 the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities. 107

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 108 pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 109 cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 110 scholarships and other educational activities. 111

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 112 pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 113 organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 114 contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 115 that organization. 116

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar117receives pursuant to section 4503.506 of the Revised Code to118Ohio demolay, which shall use the contributions for119scholarships, educational programs, and any other programs or120events the organization holds or sponsors in this state.121

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 122 receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 123 university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 124 collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 125 section. A university or college that receives contributions 126 from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 127 scholarship fund. 128

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 129 receives pursuant to section 4503.514 of the Revised Code to the 130 university of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana, for purposes of 131 awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend 132

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 138 receives pursuant to section 4503.521 of the Revised Code to the 139 Ohio bicycle federation to assist that organization in paying 140 for the educational programs it sponsors in support of Ohio 141 cyclists of all ages. 142

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 143 receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 144 "friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 145 incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 146 of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 147 expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 148 educational, and cultural events at the monument. 149

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 150 receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 151 fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 152 the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 153 lighthouses of fairport harbor. 154

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar155receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the156Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the157contributions only to promote and support the football team of158Washington high school of the Massillon city school district.159

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar160receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the161

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United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty-162four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron163district shall use the money it receives under this section to164pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or165sponsors within this state.166

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis international, which shall use the money it receives under this section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian activities.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 173 receives pursuant to section 4503.528 of the Revised Code to the 174 Ohio children's alliance, which shall use the money it receives 175 under this section to pay the expenses it incurs in advancing 176 its mission of sustainably improving the provision of services 177 to children, young adults, and families in this state. 178

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 179 receives pursuant to section 4503.529 of the Revised Code to the 180 Ohio nurses foundation. The foundation shall use the money it 181 receives under this section to provide educational scholarships 182 to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, 183 to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance 184 their education, and to support persons conducting nursing 185 research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and 186 the improvement of patient outcomes. 187

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar188receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the189thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation190organized under the laws of this state, to assist that191

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organization in paying for the charitable activities and 192 programs it sponsors in support of United States military 193 personnel, veterans, and their families. 194

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 195 receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 196 disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 197 programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 198 families. 199

200 The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 201 pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 202 into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 203 be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 204 hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 205 of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 206 destination. 207

The Ohio CASA/GAL association 392 shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 393 administering a program to secure the proper representation in 394 the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 395 396 children, and for the training and supervision of persons

participating in that program.

The contributions shall 407 be used to discover treatments and a cure for ALS, and to serve, 408 advocate for, and empower people affected by ALS to live their 409 lives to the fullest. 410

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the contributions into its general account to be used for purposes of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 416 receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 417 Siegel Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 418 commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 419 Cleveland, Ohio. 420

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 421 receives pursuant to section 4503.733 of the Revised Code to the 422 central Ohio chapter of the juvenile diabetes research 423 foundation, which shall distribute the contributions to the 424 chapters of the juvenile diabetes research foundation in whose 425

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geographic territory the person who paid the contribution 426 resides. 427

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar428receives pursuant to section 4503.734 of the Revised Code to the429Ohio highway patrol auxiliary foundation, which shall use the430contributions to fulfill the foundation's mission of supporting431law enforcement education and assistance.432

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 439 receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the 440 rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, 441 Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and 442 used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the 443 rotary foundation. 444

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar445receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the446Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the447contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained448under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation.449

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar450receives pursuant to section 4503.752 of the Revised Code to451buckeye corvettes, incorporated, which shall use the452contributions to pay for its charitable activities and programs.453

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 464 receives pursuant to section 4503.765 of the Revised Code to the 465 Amaranth grand chapter foundation, which shall use the 466 contributions for communal outreach, charitable service, and 467 scholarship purposes. 468
