**A BILL**

To amend section 2108.34, to enact section 1  
4501.027, and to repeal sections 4506.081, 2  
4507.231, and 4507.501 of the Revised Code to 3  
require the Registrar of Motor Vehicles and 4  
Deputy Registrars to ask each person renewing a 5  
motor vehicle registration to contribute to the 6  
Second Chance Trust Fund. 7

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 2108.34 be amended and section 8  
4501.027 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 9

**Sec. 2108.34.** (A) There is hereby created in the state 10  
treasury the second chance trust fund. The fund shall consist of 11  
voluntary contributions deposited as provided in sections 12  
4501.027 and 4503.721, ~~4506.081, 4507.231, and 4507.501~~ of the 13  
Revised Code. All investment earnings of the fund shall be 14  
credited to the fund. 15

(B) The director of health shall use the money in the fund 16  
only for the following purposes: 17

(1) Development and implementation of a campaign that 18

explains and promotes the second chance trust fund; 19

(2) Development and implementation of local and statewide 20  
public education programs about organ, tissue, and eye donation, 21  
including the informational material required to be provided 22  
under ~~sections 4506.081, 4507.231, and 4507.501~~ section 4501.027 23  
of the Revised Code; 24

(3) Development and implementation of local and statewide 25  
donor awareness programs in schools; 26

(4) Development and implementation of local and statewide 27  
programs to recognize donor families; 28

(5) Development and distribution of materials promoting 29  
organ, tissue, and eye donation; 30

(6) Cooperation with the Ohio Supreme Court, Ohio State 31  
Bar Association, and law schools of this state to more 32  
effectively educate attorneys about the donation of anatomical 33  
gifts and to encourage them to assist their clients in donating 34  
anatomical gifts through anatomical gift declarations, durable 35  
powers of attorney for health care, declarations as defined in 36  
section 2133.01 of the Revised Code, wills, and any other 37  
appropriate means; 38

(7) Cooperation with the state medical board, state 39  
medical, osteopathic, and ophthalmological associations, and 40  
colleges of medicine and osteopathic medicine in this state to 41  
more effectively educate physicians about the donation of 42  
anatomical gifts and to encourage them to assist their patients 43  
in making declarations of anatomical gifts; 44

(8) Development of statewide hospital training programs to 45  
encourage and facilitate compliance with sections 2108.14 and 46  
2108.15 of the Revised Code; 47

(9) Reimbursement of the bureau of motor vehicles for the 48  
administrative costs incurred in the performance of duties under 49  
~~sections 4506.081, 4507.231, and 4507.501~~ section 4501.027 of 50  
the Revised Code; 51

(10) Reimbursement of the department of health for 52  
administrative costs incurred in the performance of duties under 53  
this section and section 2108.35 of the Revised Code; 54

(11) Reimbursement of members of the second chance fund 55  
advisory committee for actual and necessary expenses incurred in 56  
the performance of official duties. 57

(C) The director shall make the materials developed under 58  
division (B) (5) of this section available to other state 59  
agencies. 60

(D) The director shall consider recommendations made by 61  
the second chance trust fund advisory committee pursuant to 62  
section 2108.35 of the Revised Code. The director shall 63  
determine the appropriateness of and approve or disapprove 64  
projects recommended by the advisory committee for funding and 65  
approve or disapprove the disbursement of money from the second 66  
chance trust fund. 67

Sec. 4501.027. (A) The registrar of motor vehicles or a 68  
deputy registrar shall ask whether each of the following wish to 69  
make a one-dollar voluntary contribution to the second chance 70  
trust fund established under section 2108.34 of the Revised 71  
Code: 72

(1) A person applying for or renewing a driver's license, 73  
motorcycle operator's endorsement, or duplicate; 74

(2) A person applying for an identification card or 75  
duplicate under section 4507.51 of the Revised Code; 76

(3) A person applying for or renewing a commercial 77  
driver's license, restricted commercial driver's license, or 78  
duplicate; 79

(4) A person renewing a motor vehicle registration. 80

(B) The registrar or deputy registrar also shall make 81  
available to the person informational material provided by the 82  
department of health on the importance of organ, tissue, and eye 83  
donation. 84

(C) All donations collected under this section during each 85  
month shall be forwarded by the registrar or deputy registrar 86  
not later than the fifth day of the immediately following month 87  
to the treasurer of state, who shall deposit them in the second 88  
chance fund. 89

**Section 2.** That existing section 2108.34 of the Revised 90  
Code is hereby repealed. 91

**Section 3.** That sections 4506.081, 4507.231, and 4507.501 92  
of the Revised Code are hereby repealed. 93
