5 extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and
6 regulatory authority of the Board; and generally relating to the State Board of
7 Examiners in Optometry.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
