- An Act to provide for the dismissal of charges against pregnant women for certain controlled substance offenses under certain circumstances.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:
- 22-42-23. Controlled Substance--Pregnant--Assault.

 If a woman who was pregnant at the time of an alleged violation of § 22-42-5 or

 22-42-5.1 provides evidence that she:

 (1) Received adequate prenatal care from a licensed health care professional during her pregnancy;
- 10 (2) Actively enrolled in an addiction recovery program before the child was born;
- 11 (3) Remained in the program after delivery; and
- 12 (4) Completed the addiction recovery program,
- the state shall dismiss the charge.
