- 5 FOR the purpose of establishing in Montgomery County a consumption only marketplace 6 license; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the license to the 7 developer of a commercial shopping center if the commercial shopping center meets 8 certain criteria; authorizing the license holder to allow the consumption of beer, 9 wine, and liquor in a designated outdoor area if the beer, wine, or liquor is purchased 10 from certain establishments; requiring a developer to include certain information in 11 the license application; providing for the hours of consumption for the license; 12 establishing an annual license fee; defining a certain term; and generally relating to a consumption only marketplace license in Montgomery County. 13

- 24 LOCATED WITHIN THE COMMERCIAL SHOPPING CENTER IF THE BEER, WINE, OR

- 26 (1) THAT IS LOCATED WITHIN THE COMMERCIAL SHOPPING CENTER;
- 27 (2) FOR WHICH A CLASS B LICENSE, CLASS BD-BWL LICENSE, OR
- 28 CLASS H LICENSE HAS BEEN ISSUED;
- 29 (3) IS CONTIGUOUS TO THE DESIGNATED OUTDOOR AREA; AND

4 5 6	(1) A DESCRIPTION OF THE DESIGNATED OUTDOOR AREA AND A LIST OF THE CONTIGUOUS LICENSE HOLDERS WHOSE BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR MAY BE CONSUMED IN THE DESIGNATED OUTDOOR AREA; AND
7 8	(2) A SECURITY PLAN THAT HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT <u>OF POLICE</u> .
9 10 11	(F) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY ALLOW THE CONSUMPTION OF BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR IN THE DESIGNATED OUTDOOR AREA ON MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY FROM 11 A.M. TO 11 P.M.
12	(G) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$4,000.
13 14	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
