3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Infant Formula Pro-
- 5 tection Act of 2017".

6 SEC. 2. EXPIRED INFANT FORMULA.

- 7 (a) ADULTERATION.—Section 412(a) of the Federal
- 8 Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 350a(a)) is
- 9 amended—

(1) in paragraph (2), by striking "or" at the 1 2 end; 3 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking the period at the end and inserting ", or"; and 4 5 (3) by adding at the end the following: 6 "(4) such infant formula's use-by date, as spec-7 ified in the formula's labeling in accordance with 8 section 107.20 of title 21, Code of Federal Regula-9 tions (or any successor regulations), has passed.". (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-10 section (a) applies beginning on the date that is 6 months 11 after the date of enactment of this Act. 12

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
