3 **Unit – Information From Units of State Government**

5 Ethics Commission in a certain manner for the Ethics Commission to make a certain
6 determination; and generally relating to public ethics and public official

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – General Provisions**

16 5–208.

17 (a) With advice from the Secretary of Budget and Management and in accordance
18 with § 5–103 of this title, the Ethics Commission shall determine whether an individual in
19 an executive unit is a public official for the purposes of this title.

20 (b) The Secretary of Budget and Management shall provide advice under
21 subsection (a) of this section to the Ethics Commission:

22 (1) annually; and

(2) at any other time on request of the Ethics Commission.

(C) ON REQUEST OF THE ETHICS COMMISSION, THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES SHALL PROVIDE TO THE ETHICS COMMISSION IN A TIMELY MANNER ANY INFORMATION NECESSARY FOR THE ETHICS COMMISSION TO MAKE A DETERMINATION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION:

(1) THE SECRETARY OF A PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH;

(2) THE PRESIDENT OF A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION, AS DEFINED IN § 10–101 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE; AND

(3) A UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
