BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5	SECTION 1.		
6	Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to sales and us		
7	taxes, is amended by revising paragraph (50) of Code Section 48-8-3, relating to exemption		
8	from state sales and use taxes, as follows:		
9	"(50)(A) Sales of insulin syringes and blood glucose level measuring strips dispense		
10	without a prescription.		
11	(B) The sale or use of products with the primary purpose of absorbing or capturing		
12	menstrual flow, including but not limited to tampons, menstrual pads and sanitary		
13	napkins, panty liners, menstrual sponges, and menstrual cups;"
