- 16 "(2) With respect to a work that wins a covered com-
- 17 petition, the Register of Copyrights—
- 18 "(A) shall waive the requirement under sub-
- section (a)(1) with respect to an application for reg-
- 20 istration of a copyright claim for that work if that
- application is submitted to the Copyright Office not
- later than the last day of the calendar year following
