A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Property Tax - Credit for Accessibility Design Features - Newly Constructed Apartment Buildings

FOR the purpose of expanding a certain property tax credit authorized against the county 4 $\mathbf{5}$ or municipal corporation property tax for residential real property equipped with a 6 certain accessibility feature to include certain newly constructed apartment 7 buildings; authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the governing body of a county or municipal corporation to define, by law, certain accessibility or 8 9 universal design features that qualify for the credit; altering a certain definition; defining a certain term; providing for the application of this Act; and generally 10 11 relating to a local property tax credit for real property equipped with certain 12accessibility features.
