A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to expand eligibility for the paycheck protection program, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF COVERED ENTITIES FOR THE
4	PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM.
5	(a) In General.—Section 7(a)(36) of the Small
6	Business Act (15 U.S.C. 636(a)(36)) is amended—
7	(1) in subparagraph (A)—
8	(A) in clause (viii), by striking "and" at
9	the end;

1	(B) in clause (ix), by striking the period at
2	the end and inserting a semicolon; and
3	(C) by adding at the end the following:
4	"(x) the term 'covered entity'
5	means—
6	"(I) financial businesses (as de-
7	fined in section 120.110(b) of title 13,
8	Code of Federal Regulations); and
9	"(II) legal gambling businesses
10	(as described under section
11	120.110(g) of title 13, Code of Fed-
12	eral Regulations)."; and
13	(2) in subparagraph (D), by inserting "covered
14	entity," after "veterans organization," each place it
15	appears.
