A BILL

To require the Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection to issue a rule before deleting or modifying certain small business loan data, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bank Loan Privacy
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RULEMAKING REQUIREMENT.**

7 Section 704B(e)(4) of the Equal Credit Opportunity
8 Act (15 U.S.C. 1691e–2(e)(4)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “The Bureau may,” and insert-
2 ing:

3 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Bureau may,”;
4 and

5 (2) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(B) RULEMAKING REQUIREMENT.—The
7 Bureau shall, before deleting or modifying data
8 under this paragraph issue, through advance
9 notice and comment, a rule that includes a de-
10 scription of what modifications and deletions
11 the Bureau intends to make to the data and
12 how such modifications and deletions will ad-
13 vance a privacy interest.”.
