## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to emergency management organization and administration, so as to authorize
- 3 emergency personnel to go upon private property as necessary in the performance of their
- 4 duties during a state of emergency or state of disaster; to prohibit the interference with
- 5 emergency personnel performing their duties; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 emergency management organization and administration, is amended by adding a new Code
- 11 section to read as follows:
- 12 <u>"38-3-38.</u>
- 13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'emergency responder' means any person who
- is deployed to respond to a state of emergency or state of disaster under the direction and
- control of any federal, state, or local government entity authorized to deploy such person.
- 16 (b) During any state of emergency or state of disaster declared by the Governor pursuant
- 17 <u>to Code Section 38-3-51, all emergency responders shall be authorized to enter upon</u>
- private property to the extent necessary to conduct their duties with regard to such
- 19 emergency or disaster, including but not limited to search, rescue, property protection,
- 20 <u>debris removal, restoration of services, and infrastructure repair and relocation.</u>
- 21 (c) No person shall interfere with or obstruct any emergency responder in the performance
- of his or her duties."

SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
