 30, 2027".

8 SEC. 2. REPORT.

9 Not later than 3 years after the date of the enact-10 ment of this Act, the Federal Trade Commission shall transmit to the Committee on Energy and Commerce of 11 the House of Representatives and the Committee on Com-12 13 merce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate a report describing its use of and experience with the authority 14 15 granted by the U.S. SAFE WEB Act of 2006 (Public Law 109–455) and the amendments made by such Act. The 16 report shall include— 17

18 (1) the number of cross-border complaints re-19 ceived and acted upon by the Commission;

20 (2) identification of the foreign agencies with
21 which the Commission has cooperated and the re22 sults of such cooperation, including any foreign
23 agency enforcement action or lack thereof;

(3) a description of Commission litigation
 brought in foreign courts and the results of such liti gation; and

4 (4) any recommendations for legislation that
5 may advance the mission of the Commission in car6 rying out the U.S. SAFE WEB Act of 2006 and the
7 amendments made by such Act.
