- 16 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:
- 17 (1) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF THE 18 OFFICER'S DUTY;

19(2) AN OFF-DUTY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OR A PERSON WHO20HAS RETIRED AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN GOOD STANDING FROM A LAW21ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OF THE UNITED STATES, THE STATE, OR A LOCAL UNIT IN22THE STATE WHO IS A PARENT, GUARDIAN, OR VISITOR OF A STUDENT ATTENDING A



1 SCHOOL LOCATED ON THE PROPERTY OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER 2 EDUCATION, IF:

3 (I) THE OFFICER OR RETIRED OFFICER IS DISPLAYING THE 4 OFFICER'S OR RETIRED OFFICER'S BADGE OR CREDENTIAL;

5 (II) THE WEAPON CARRIED OR POSSESSED BY THE OFFICER OR 6 RETIRED OFFICER IS CONCEALED; AND

7 (III) THE OFFICER OR RETIRED OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO 8 CARRY A CONCEALED HANDGUN IN THE STATE;

9 (3) A PERSON HIRED BY A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER 10 EDUCATION SPECIFICALLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF GUARDING THE PUBLIC 11 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION; OR

12 (4) ANY OTHER PERSON WHO IS AUTHORIZED TO CARRY OR POSSESS 13 A FIREARM FOR ACADEMIC OR EMPLOYMENT PURPOSES AS DETERMINED BY THE 14 GOVERNING BODY OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

15(B) A PERSON MAY NOT CARRY OR POSSESS A FIREARM WHILE KNOWINGLY16ON THE PROPERTY OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

17 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND 18 ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING **3** YEARS OR A FINE 19 NOT EXCEEDING **\$2,500** OR BOTH.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2017.
