A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Honorable Justice Keith R. Blackwell; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Justice Keith R. Blackwell was appointed to the Supreme Court of Georgia in
- 3 July, 2012, by Governor Nathan Deal and previously served as a judge of the Court of
- 4 Appeals of Georgia, a position to which he was appointed by Governor Sonny Perdue; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Justice Blackwell was born on the Fourth of July and raised in Cherokee
- 6 County, where he graduated as valedictorian from Cherokee High School; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Justice Blackwell is a proud Double Dawg, having attended the University of
- 8 Georgia, from which he graduated summa cum laude as First Honor Graduate, and the
- 9 University of Georgia School of Law, where he served as senior editor of the Georgia Law
- 10 Review, was elected to the Order of the Coif, and graduated summa cum laude again as First
- 11 Honor Graduate; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Justice Blackwell served as a law clerk to Judge J.L. Edmondson of the United
- 13 States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit and practiced law with Alston & Bird,
- served as an assistant district attorney in Cobb County, and later joined Parker, Hudson,
- 15 Rainer & Dobbs where he was elected as a partner; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Justice Blackwell, during his service on the State Supreme Court, has
- 17 exemplified the characteristics of a dedicated public servant to the citizens of Georgia above
- and beyond his service as a Justice, by also serving as the Supreme Court liaison to the State
- 19 Bar of Georgia and to the Office of Bar Admission and Board of Bar Examiners, as chair of
- 20 the Commission on Interpreters, as a member of the Commission on Dispute Resolution, as
- 21 a liaison to the Strategic Planning Committee of the Judicial Council, as a master of the
- 22 Joseph Henry Lumpkin American Inn of Court and the Columbus American Inn of Court,
- 23 as a member of the Board of Advisors for the Atlanta Chapter of the Federalist Society for
- Law and Public Policy Studies, as a member of the Governor's Appellate Jurisdiction Reform

25 Commission, as a member of the Governor's Judicial Nominating Commission, and as an

- 26 advisor to the Georgia House of Representatives Judiciary Committee with respect to the
- 27 revision of the state evidence code; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Justice Blackwell, through his decade of service as an appellate jurist has
- 29 personified the role of a judge dedicated to the rule of law, never forgetting that the state
- 30 exists to preserve freedom, that the separation of governmental powers is central to our
- 31 Constitution, and that it is emphatically the province and duty of the judiciary to say what
- 32 the law is, not what it should be; and
- 33 WHEREAS, Justice Blackwell has always exhibited the characteristics most cherished of a
- 34 judge through his superior intellect, collegial nature, and his kindness shown to those who
- 35 appeared before him in argument and to his colleagues on the Supreme Court; and
- 36 WHEREAS, Justice Blackwell, routinely throughout his appellate career, has managed to
- 37 work into oral argument uniquely applicable hypotheticals related to *Smokey and the Bandit*,
- 38 Trans Ams, and *Red Dawn*, to say nothing of the importance of pie; and
- 39 WHEREAS, Justice Blackwell is a devoted husband and father and, having announced his
- 40 retirement from the Supreme Court of Georgia, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the
- 41 outstanding accomplishments of this remarkable and distinguished Georgia be appropriately
- 42 recognized.
- 43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 44 the members of this body commend Justice Keith Blackwell for his many years of dedicated
- 45 public service as a member of the Court of Appeals of Georgia and as a Justice on the
- 46 Supreme Court of Georgia; congratulate him upon the occasion of his retirement; and extend
- 47 to him their most sincere best wishes for continued health and happiness.
