- (1) Preliminary report.—Not later than 540 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall submit to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the House of Representatives a preliminary report on the findings of the Comptroller General with respect to the study required by subsection (a).
- (2) Final Report.—Upon completion of the study, the Comptroller General shall submit to such committees a final report on such study.
