## A BILL ENTITLED

2 Sports Wagering Campaign Contributions Parity Act of 2023

- FOR the purpose of repealing a prohibition on applicants for and holders of a certain video lottery operation license and persons who own an interest in video lottery facility operations in the State from directly or indirectly making contributions to certain campaign finance entities; and generally relating to contributions by persons with an interest in video lottery operations.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

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1 **(4)** "Video lottery operation license" has the meaning stated in § 9–1A–01 2 of the State Government Article. 3 (b) This section applies to the following persons: an applicant for a video lottery operation license; 4 (1) a holder of a video lottery operation license; or 5 (2) 6 a person who owns an interest in the operation of a video lottery facility (3) 7 in this State. 8 This section does not apply to gaming activity that an eligible organization is (c) 9 authorized to conduct under the Criminal Law Article. 10 A person subject to this section may not, directly or indirectly, make a (d) 11 contribution to: 12 the campaign finance entity of a candidate for any nonfederal public (1) 13 office in the State; or 14 **(2)** any other campaign finance entity organized in support of a candidate for any nonfederal public office in the State.] 15
