A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to certificates of fitness for plumbers and electricians."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3	* Section 1. AS 18.62.020 is amended to read:
4	Sec. 18.62.020. Application for and issuance of certificate. The department
5	shall issue certificates of fitness and renewal certificates of fitness valid for two years.
6	The certificate may be issued only to an individual. An applicant for a certificate shall
7	apply in writing, under oath, on a form prescribed by the department containing
8	(1) the name and address of the applicant;
9	(2) the applicant's age;
10	(3) the applicant's citizenship; [AND]
11	(4) other information relevant to licensing that the department
12	requires <u>: and</u>
13	(5) proof that the applicant
14	(A) has successfully completed an apprenticeship program
15	approved by the department or an apprenticeship program equivalent to

1	a program approved by the department; or
2	(B) holds a verification of qualifications under
3	AS 18.62.050(c).
4	* Sec. 2. AS 18.62.050(a) is amended to read:
5	(a) If, upon investigation and examination by the department, an [THE]
6	applicant who submits a completed application and required fee is found
7	competent by reason of training and experience, the department shall issue a certificate
8	of fitness. The department may not issue a certificate unless the applicant has
9	been found to have successfully completed an approved apprenticeship or
10	apprenticeship equivalent or has a valid verification under (c) of this section. The
11	certificate shall set out the competency of the applicant and provide for positive
12	identification of the applicant, and shall be carried on the person engaged in work
13	subject to the requirement of a certificate of fitness under this chapter.
