Mr. BEN RAY LUJÁN of New Mexico (for himself and Ms. MICHELLE LUJAN GRISHAM of New Mexico) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To provide that the pueblo of Santa Clara may lease for 99 years certain restricted land, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF PUEBLO OF SANTA CLARA**
4 **LAND ELIGIBLE FOR 99-YEAR LEASE.**

5 Subsection (a) of the first section of the Act of Au-
6 gust 9, 1955 (commonly known as the “Long-Term Leas-
7 ing Act”) (25 U.S.C. 415(a)), is amended—

8 (1) by striking “Indians,,” and inserting “Indi-
9 ans,”;

1 (2) by inserting “Ohkay Owingeh pueblo,” after
2 “Cochiti,”;

3 (3) by inserting “the pueblo of Santa Clara,”
4 after “Pojoaque,”;

5 (4) by striking “the the lands” and inserting
6 “the land”;

7 (5) by striking “lands held in trust for the
8 Pueblo of Santa Clara,”; and

9 (6) by striking “lands held in trust for Ohkay
10 Owingeh Pueblo”.
