To require a review of Department of Homeland Security trusted traveler programs, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Trusted Traveler Re-3 consideration and Restoration Act of 2019".

4 SEC. 2. COMPTROLLER GENERAL REVIEW.

Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment
of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States
shall conduct a review of Department of Homeland Security trusted traveler programs. Such review shall examine
the following:

10 (1) The extent to which the Department of 11 Homeland Security tracks data and monitors trends 12 related to trusted traveler programs, including root 13 causes for identity-matching errors resulting in an 14 individual's enrollment in a trusted traveler program 15 being reinstated.

(2) Whether the Department coordinates with
the heads of other relevant Federal, State, local,
Tribal, or territorial entities regarding redress procedures for disqualifying offenses not covered by the
Department's own redress processes but which offenses impact an individual's enrollment in a trusted
traveler program.

23 (3) How the Department may improve individ24 uals' access to reconsideration procedures regarding

any other Federal, State, local, Tribal, or territorial

3 (4) The extent to which travelers are informed
4 about reconsideration procedures regarding enroll5 ment in a trusted traveler program.

6 SEC. 3. ENROLLMENT REDRESS.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall, with respect to an individual whose enrollment in a trusted traveler program was
revoked in error extend by an amount of time equal to
the period of revocation the period of active enrollment
in such a program upon re-enrollment in such a program
by such an individual.
