1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 4 This Act may be cited as the "John Muir National Historic Site Expansion Act". 5 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS. 6 7 In this Act: 8 (1) HISTORIC SITE.—The term "Historic Site" 9 means the John Muir National Historic Site in Martinez, California, established by Public Law 88-547 10 11 (78 Stat. 753). 12 (2) MAP.—The term "map" means the map enti-13 tled "John Muir National Historic Site Proposed Boundary Expansion", numbered 426/127150, and 14 15 dated November 2014. (3) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means 16 17 the Secretary of the Interior. 18 SEC. 3. JOHN MUIR NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE LAND ACQUI-19 SITION. 20 (a) ACQUISITION.—The Secretary may acquire by do-21 nation the approximately 44 acres of land and any interests 22 in the land that is identified on the map. 23 (b) BOUNDARY.—On the acquisition of the land au-24 thorized under subsection (a), the Secretary shall adjust the boundaries of the Historic Site to include the acquired land. 25

(c) ADMINISTRATION.—The land and any interests in
land acquired under subsection (a) shall be administered
as part of the National Historic Site.
